Who can submit a report

The Company hereby excludes the receipt of reports from any person who does not perform work or other similar activity for the Company in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 (3) a), b), h) or i) of the Act. Thus, a natural person who is performing work or other similar activity for the Company in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 (3) a), b), h) or i) of the Act may submit a report.

What can be reported

In accordance with the provision of Section 2 (1) of the Act, a potential illegal act that occurred or is about to occur at the Company and that:

- has the characteristics of a criminal offence,
- has the characteristics of a misdemeanor for which the law sets the rate of fine, the upper limit of which is at least CZK 100,000,
- violates the Act, or
- violates another legal regulation or regulation of the European Union in the area of
 - financial services, statutory audit and other verification services, financial products and financial markets,
 - corporate income taxes,
 - preventing the money laundering and terrorist financing,
 - consumer protection,
 - compliance with product requirements, including product safety,
 - transport, traffic and road safety,
 - o protection of the environment,
 - o food and feed safety and the protection of animals and their health,
 - o radiation protection and nuclear safety,
 - o economic competition, public auctions and public procurement,
 - o protection of internal order and security, life and health,
 - protection of personal data, privacy and security of electronic communications networks and information systems,
 - o protection of the financial interests of the European Union, or
 - the functioning of the internal market, including the protection of economic competition and state aid according to European Union law,

can be reported.

Content of the report

The report must contain the name, surname and date of birth or other information from which the identity of the whistleblower can be deduced. **The Company does not accept any anonymous** *reports.*

Report must not contain knowingly false information, i.e., information that the whistleblower has no reasonable grounds to believe is based on the truth.

A report shall not be deemed to be that part of the report which contains information the report of which could immediately endanger the essential security interest of the Czech Republic, about the activities of the intelligence services of the Czech Republic, or the report of which would constitute a breach of the duty of confidentiality of the clergy in connection with the exercise of confessional secrecy or a right similar to confessional secrecy.

The extent and quality of the information provided can positively influence the way in which the report is investigated and the appropriate corrective and preventive action taken, where appropriate. Please note that you will help us investigate your report if you identify the area of the violation and share with us details of the alleged violation, such as the date, time or period during which the alleged violation occurred, exactly what the violation was, who committed the violation, how you learned of the violation, identify witnesses, etc.
